- Maintenance practices to maximise product appearance and thus extend the product life cycle

The Andrews Group Product Stewardship policy embraces the principle that wherever possible alternatives to sending products to landfill will be implemented.

In accordance with this policy commitment, The Andrews Group specifically offers:

- Acceptance of materials wastage from the installation process for recycling
- Disassembly of BOLON woven flooring products for materials recycling by the approved recycling company for BOLON in Australia, Cryogrind P/L

These commitments are effected through the implementation of a specific product stewardship agreement, which is tailored to suit the requirements of the individual project.

The Andrews Group will continue to refine, improve and expand our Product Stewardship initiatives to provide cost effective life cycle management solutions that are environmentally beneficial and economically sensible.
